Why?

COMES NOW the Plaintiff Ronnie & Lila Long and In support of the Petition for a Temporary Restraining Order alleges that an emergency situation exists for the following reasons: The Bank of Hauen Wrongfully canceled our loan and took possession of 22.25 acres of our land. And Ed Maciejewski has physically taken possession of ~~my~~ the land. There by my winter hay and pasturing for my ranching operation has been seriously impaired by the Bank of Hauen and Ed Maciejewski. Irreparable damage has occurred because of this action and will continue to occur if they are not restrained. There for I'm requesting this restraining order be issued and continue in effect until this matter is resolved. Being the Bank of Hauen and B.J.A. are in the court of appeal in Washington DC. and we as members of the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe are torn between the Bank of Hauen and the B.J.A.

Wherefore, Plaintiff moves that a Temporary Restraining Order be issued on the ground that immediate and irreparable harm, damage, and injury may result to Plaintiff before a hearing can be held on Plaintiff's request for permanent restraining order.

The Plaintiffs in the above-entitled action having made a showing under oath to the Court that irreparable harm will result if this Court does not issue its Temporary Restraining Order, the Court having found that Bank of Hoven engaged in self-help in violation of tribal law and that a complaint duly executed has been filed with this Court by the Plaintiffs requesting this Temporary Restraining Order and the Court finding good cause to be shown, now **THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED THAT THE ABOVE DEFENDANTS ED MACIEJEWSKI AND BANK OF HOVEN are HEREBY RESTRAINED FROM PERFORMING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:**

Said Defendant is immediately and forthwith prohibited and restrained from entering or disturbing the property and selling the Plaintiff's property that is described (see attached lease agreement) dated December 05, 1996 and from transferring the title and any property that is part and partial of this lease.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that failure of the Defendants to comply with this Temporary Restraining Order will result in Contempt of Court proceedings against the Defendants.

A rescheduled hearing on this Temporary Restraining Order will be held on **FRIDAY, JULY 30, 1999 @ 03:00 PM** at the Judges Chamber's at which time the Defendant shall appear and show cause why this order should not be made permanent and remain in full force and effect.


