ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Count 4 of the Complaint, insofar as it prays for rescission of the voluntary deed of conveyance executed by the personal representative of the estate of Kenneth L. Long for an alleged fraud in the inducement, is DISMISSED without prejudice to any rights of the Plaintiff to assert such an action in state court. To the extent the count requests rescission based upon failure of consideration the motion is DENIED, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the motions to dismiss the other counts are DENIED, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Court will permit testimony regarding the circumstances surrounding the execution of the voluntary deed of conveyance only insofar as it is relevant to the Plaintiff's other counts and is pertinent to the Plaintiffs' claims that they gave consideration to the Bank for the alleged promises made by the Bank and the Bank breached those promises.
